Galatians 1:3-5

The letter you need, but at first read may not want

From: vs 1, 2a

Paul – a *true authoritative* <u>Apostle</u>, along with all the believers in Jesus Christ who are with Paul

<u>**To:**</u> v 2b

The believers (in Jesus Christ) in the Galatian churches

1. Opening Gospel Truth, and Encouragement v3-5

<u>Grace</u> to you AND <u>Peace</u> to you from God <u>our</u> Father and the <u>Lord</u> Jesus the <u>Christ</u> v3

This Jesus gave His very self for the sake of our sins. $\nu 4$

• He did this to deliver and rescue us from a time such as this. A time that is evil, ungodly, and contrary to all that God is and Jesus represents.

Jesus gave His life in our place, to be the payment for our sins against God. He did this according to the Father's perfect plan and will.

To this gracious God through whom peace is given be ALL glory, today, tomorrow, and forever - always. $\nu 5$

What has Paul stated, and what has he not included in this opening statement to the churches of Galatia? "I thank God for you..."

• Eph 1:16, Phil 1:3, Col 1:3-4, I Thess 1:2-5a, 2 Thess 1:3-4, 2 Tim 1:3-5

In this letter we will read how Paul is "<u>astonished</u>" (1:6) and "<u>perplexed</u>" (4:20) at the Galatians trust in a false "gospel".

Paul says the Galatian churches by ignoring "grace and peace" are:

- \varnothing "foolish & bewitched (3:1)
- Ø "cursed" (3:10)
- arnothing "held captive and imprisoned" (3:23
- \varnothing "enslaved to the world" (4:10)
- \oslash "hindered & persuaded" (5:7)

2. Walking in the Sufficiency of the Gospel of Jesus Christ

The "Do's and Do Not's"

- 1. Do know Christ. I Cor 2:2, Mt 7:21-23
- 2. Do believe, and trust in Jesus. Rom 8:22-25
- 3. Do <u>abide</u> in Jesus as He abides in you. Rom 8:10-11, Jn 15:4-5, 17:26; Col 1:29, Titus 2:11-14
- 4. Do not <u>add</u> to the <u>Gospel</u>!
 - Gal 3:1-3, Rev 22:18, 2 Tim 3:14-15, Titus 2:15
- 5. Do not take away from the Gospel!
 - Gal 2:21, Rev 22:19, 2 Tim 3:16, Titus 2:15
- 6. Do not <u>deny</u> the power and work of the <u>Gospel</u>!
 - Rom 1:16, 1 Cor 1:18, 1 Thess 1:5, I Jn 3:8b-10, 2 Tim 3:17

3. Gospel Reminders for Us to Trust in

- $\sqrt{}$ We have a heavenly Father who <u>loves</u> us Jn 3:16
- $\sqrt{}$ Jesus, according to His Father's will, gave himself for our <u>sins</u> Phil 2:8
- $\sqrt{}$ His death <u>delivered</u> us from the present evil age 2 Cor 1:10
- $\sqrt{}$ To <u>God</u> be the glory, always. Gal 1:5a, Phil 4:20, Rom 11:36
- $\sqrt{}$ Amen we affirm, believe, and are in agreement. Gal 1:5b
